Teacher education in times of crisis: multiple dimensions

In the event, there will be 4 plenary sessions, 1 round table, the traditional Latin-American Panel, 320 individual and coordinated paper sessions, and a poster session limited to a maximum of 40 posters.

Proposals for the individual and coordinated paper sessions, **focusing on language teacher education**, will be organized under the following topics:

The proposals, **based on the topics above**, are supposed to be submitted to the following modalities:

	Duration	Description
Coordinated Paper sessions	2 hours	Presentation and discussion of three to four papers produced by researchers who share interests to be approached from different perspectives. The proposals will be submitted by a coordinator-professor or PhD researcher, who will be responsible for selecting and sending them to the Organizing Committee. Each session will last 2 hours and the coordinator is supposed to organize the schedule in a way that it encompasses enough time for presentations and discussion.
Individual Paper sessions	30 minutes	20-minute oral presentations, followed by a period of 10 minutes for questions and discussion. The proposals will be grouped by the Organizing Committee according to similar themes.
Poster session	60 minutes	Each water-proof-90cm x 120cm poster will be submitted and presented by one or two authors. Poster presenter(s) must be present to discuss it during the scheduled session.

Each participant can be author or co-author of only one paper, of any modality.

The official languages for the event are English, Portuguese, and Spanish. The participants must present in the same language they submitted their proposals.

The Committee will provide interpreting to Portuguese for the participants who present in LIBRAS.

The selection of the papers for coordinated and individual paper sessions and the posters will be conducted by the VII CLAFPL Scientific Committee.

The submission guidelines will be explained on the 2nd Call.
